



How to Build a curriculum alignment chart on Quantiles.com

Using the QTaxon search, one can build a curriculum alignment chart which depicts the state curriculum and aligned QTaxons. Follow the following steps for building a chart. For pdf copies of the charts, please see your state education agency website or contact them directly. A copy of these curriculum alignment charts have been given to each state that reports Quantile measures.

1. Go to the QTaxon Search page from the Home Page or the Tools Page:
2. Click on “Advanced Search”

*If you are in a state that has been aligned to the Quantile Framework, you can select your state and see the state goals for the QTaxons.

3. Once at the Advanced Search Screen, complete the following search criteria: (only choose a state and a grade, leave all others as-is.)

4. When the results come up on the page (and there will be more than one page for most grades), click on the column header labeled: “State Goal”. This will re-sort the results by state objectives, TEKS, goals, whatever your state calls their grade level expectations. Then go to File → then Print. You have now printed a grade alignment chart for your state curriculum. Remember to print all pages. Repeat for each grade.
