To perform a basic search, enter the title of the textbook (ie: *Math Advantage*) in the Title/keywords box. You may also search by Publisher, ISBN\* number or grade. If you constrain the search by grade and state and do not find the book you are looking for, remove this criteria. To search by ISBN, simply type the 10 or 13 digits into the search box. Do not include the dashes.

### \* *What is an ISBN?*



The ISBN (International Standard Book Number) is a 10- or 13-digit number used for identification. An ISBN is unique to every book, so it is the easiest way to find the exact edition.

The ISBN is always found on the back cover, near the bar code. It is always labeled ISBN (e.g. ISBN 0-00-470779-6).
